What is Mixed Delivery?

Virginia's Mixed Delivery program provides **full-day, year-round preschool and child care** for eligible infants, toddlers, and preschoolers – at low cost to qualifying families.



Through Mixed Delivery more of Virginia's littlest learners are able to experience high quality preschool and child care and get ready for kindergarten success. High quality preschool and child care experiences give young children opportunities to learn and practice important academic and social/emotional skills – like early math, early literacy, and increased independence.

Is my child eligible?

Your child must meet one of the eligibility criteria below:

- Child's family has an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level
- Child's family is experiencing homelessness
- Child's parent(s) or guardian(s) did not complete high school
- Child has identified disability or needs special education

All adults in your home must be participating in one of the following activities: working, job search, and/or education/training, or they are unable to provide care themselves.

Your Mixed Delivery Supervisor can help determine if your child is eligible for Mixed Delivery.
